Job Title: Board Operator/Sound Engineer for Outdoor Summer Concert Series at Rockwell Park

Department: Parks, Recreation, Youth and Community Services

Code: \$23.59/hour

Schedule: 3PM-9PM for 8 weeks on Tuesday evenings from June 25 - August. Candidates must be available on Wednesdays for rain dates, unless prior arrangements have been made

Position Goal(s): In this role, you will be tasked with preparing and operating sound for our annual summer concert series at the Rockwell Park in Bristol CT. This person will be tasked with unloading our audio equipment and working with hired bands through sound check and the concert to deliver quality sound for our patrons.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Proficient knowledge in audio mixing consoles, outboard equipment, audio routing, microphone and signal flows, mix minus, and the ability measure audio signals to ensure quality control.
- Capable of mixing and monitoring all audio sources including but not limited to, microphones, amps, return monitors.
- Problem solve and troubleshoot using effective communication to best convey issues and resolutions.
- Assist in set up and breakdown of all audio equipment
- Be able to lift and maneuver heavy equipment.
- Must work well with others.

Supervised By: Works under the direct supervision of the Arts and Culture Supervisor and Parks, Recreation, Youth and Community Services team.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

- Must have prior work with audio board/mixer and the ability to troubleshoot.

Work Environment and Physical Demands: This work is all outdoors at the Rockwell Park Amphitheater. Physical requirements include but are not limited to: walking, bending, climbing, standing, sitting, stooping, lifting, standing which may be performed for extended periods of time and/or on uneven surfaces. Ability to safely lift and move objects of up to 50 or more pounds. This list is not all-inclusive and may be supplemented as necessary.
