# Bristol Parks and Recreation 

2018 Adult Men's Softball League

## League By-Laws

## Registration

- All teams must be signed up through Bristol Parks and Recreation to participate.
- All players must sign a Bristol Parks and Recreation waiver in order to participate (will be provided to players at their first game).
- No players under 18 are allowed on a team's roster.
- A player is only allowed to participate with a single team and cannot change teams once the season has started.


## Game Play I

- Certified umpires will be used as each game.
- ASA Rules / 6’-10’ Pitch.
- Five over-the-fence home runs per team per game. Any additional homeruns end the inning and do not count. Do not run homeruns out.
- Teams MUST use ASA approved bats. Any team caught using a non-approved bat will be removed from the league without a refund.
- Batters come to plate with a 1-1 count, with $\mathbf{1}$ foul ball to waste. Once a batter has two strikes, if he hits a foul ball, he is out.
- The mercy rule is in effect -- (20 runs after 3, 15 after 4, 10 after 5).
- League director(s) will provide game balls.
- Teams will flip a coin to determine who is home/away game one. Home/away will switch game two.
- A full game is seven innings. Tie games will be continued until a team wins.
- No grace period between games.
- In the event of inclement weather, a regular season game is official if the losing team has batted at least 3 times.


## Game Play II

- $\quad 1$ courtesy runner per game (one person per game can be ran for by anyone on the bench).
- There is a double base at first base -- white base for defense and orange base for runner.
- No bunting.
- Teams must bat at least 10 players. There is no maximum number of players a team can bat.
- If a team only has 9 players, the 10 th batter is an automatic out.
- No metal spikes.
- The hitting team is responsible for getting any homeruns and foul balls that they hit
- All teams must be paid in the full before their first game in order to play in the league.


## Playoffs

- All 8 teams make the playoffs.
- Playoffs will be a double elimination format.
- Playoffs game must be completed in full (unless mercy rule applies). If inclement weather causes the game to be postponed, the league director(s) will determine a make-up date and time.
- A player must play in at least one-third of a team's regular season games to participate in playoffs; league director(s) will do their best to monitor this. Rosters will be collected no later than the end of of Week 5. Players who join teams after this can be added onto rosters but will not be eligible for playoffs.


## Sportsmanship

- Sportsmanship is expected by players at all times.
- Treat the umpire and league director(s) with respect.
- Umpires and league director(s) have full discretion to eject a player from a game.
- Any player ejected from a game an umpire or league director will have to sit the next game.
- Any player ejected twice in the same season will forfeit his right to play in the Bristol Softball League and a refund will not be given.


## Field Usage

- In inclement weather, the league director(s) will determine is a field is unplayable.
- All players must be out of the park when the lights are turned off.
- Players are not allowed to do any maintenance on city fields.
- Keep dugouts clean and throw away all garbage.
